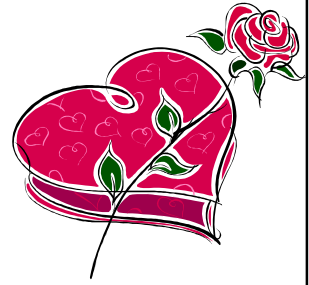


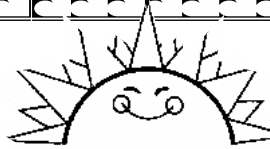

Someone Else was a wonderful person; sometimes appearing superhuman. Were the truth known, everybody expected too much of Someone Else.

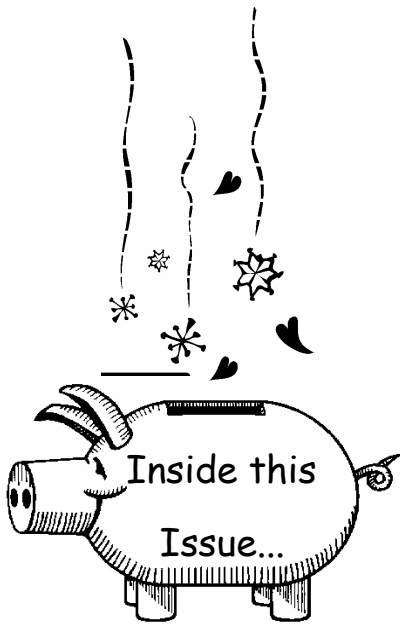
Now Someone Else is gone! We wonder what we are going to do. Someone Else left a wonderful example to follow, but who is going to follow it?

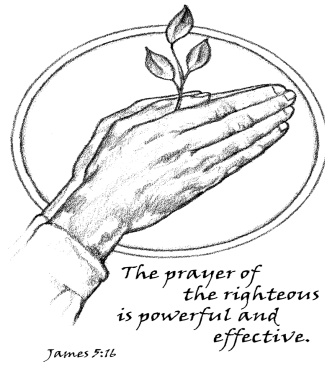

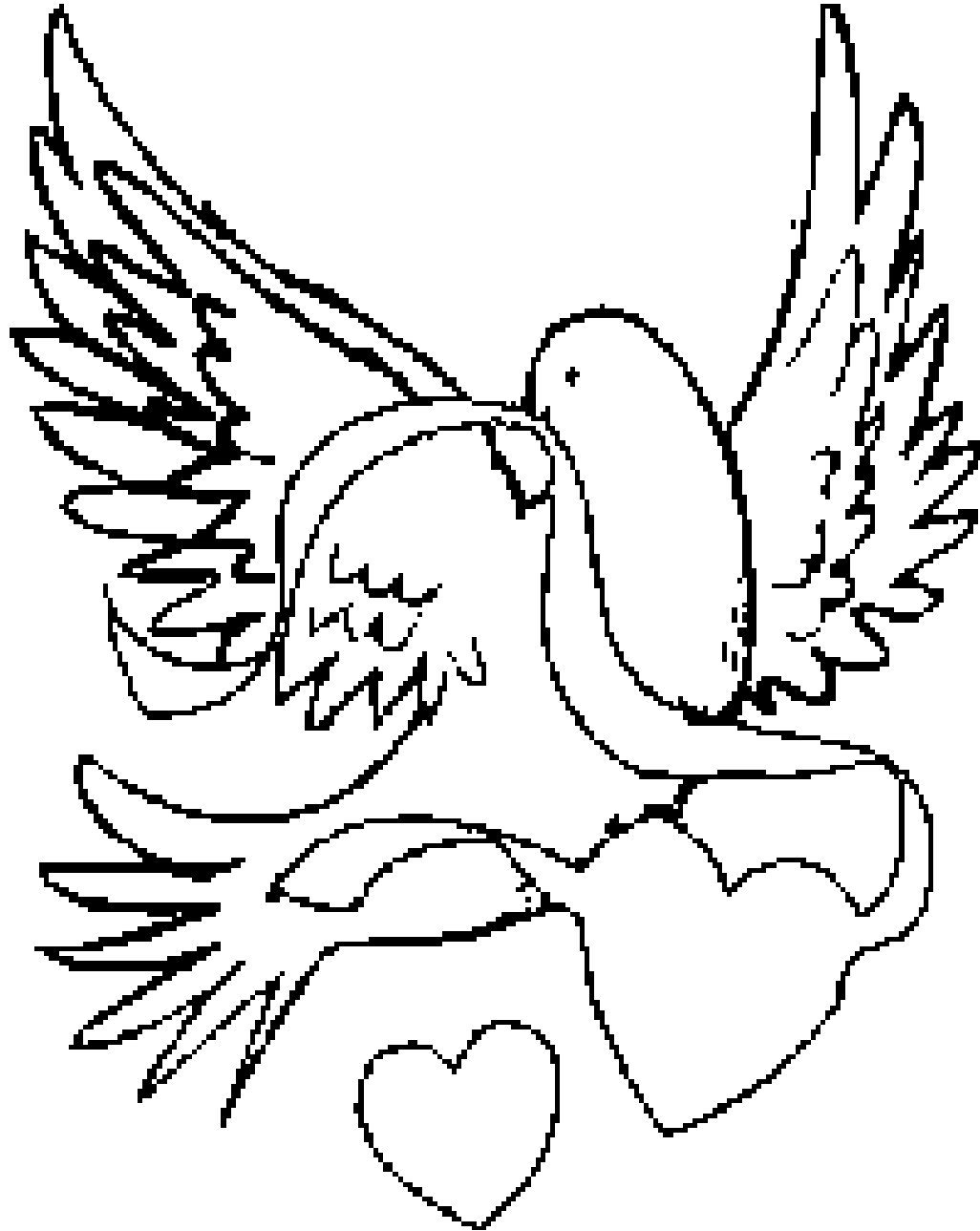

Actually, it wasn't Satan who wrote the letter but Lilly Coyle of Minneapolis writing in the persona of the hellish one.

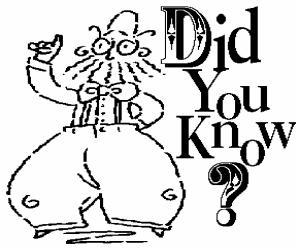
I think she got it down pretty well. What say you?

From the Constitution and Discipline of the Methodist Protestant Church. 1854(yes, it is eighteen fifty four)
"Article XII

Suffrage and Eligibility to Office.

I. Every minister and preacher, and every white, lay male member, in full communion and fellowship, having attained to the age of twenty-one years, shall be entitled to vote in all cases."

From the 2004 Book of Discipline:

PP 244 Organization plan for the local church:...

"3. Members of the church council or alternative structure shall be persons of genuine Christian character who love the church, are morally disciplined, are committed to the mandate of inclusiveness in the life of the church, are loyal to the ethical standards of The United Methodist Church set forth in the Social Principles, and are competent to administer its affairs. It shall include youth members chosen according to the same standards as adults. All persons with vote shall be members of the local church, except where central conference legislation provides otherwise. The pastor shall be the administrative officer and, as such, shall be an ex officio member of all conferences, boards, councils, commissions, committees, and task forces, unless otherwise restricted by the Discipline.5"

"We have come a long way.

Did you all get the point here? Does any part of this poem sound familiar? They say that the seven last words of the church are: "We've never done it that way before!" I disagree. I believe that the real last words of the church are: "Someone else will do it." We can't depend on someone else. The pastor can't do it all. The pastor can't be every committee person, every dinner chef, every dinner clean up, no one person can do it all! It takes everyone to make this work. What happens to the ministry when the bishop decides it is time to move your pastor? Does the ministry end, does the out reach stop, does the family fall apart?

So the next time a sign up sheet is passed around, don't pass it on and say "Someone else can do it", sign up. The next time you see something that needs fixing, fix it. The next time a special service is held, don't say, "Someone else can go", get ready and go! The next time a class needs to be taught, don't say: "Well someone else will do it", teach it. When someone needs help, help!! When you see someone hungry, lonely, hurting, sad, scared, don't say, "Someone else will take care of them", reach outside yourself and the church and feed them, visit them, hold their hand, and show them that God loves them.

When we are talking about the future of the church, don't say: "Someone else will figure it out", be a part of that solution.

We are the only instruments that God has to do accomplish all this. Remember the words of Christ recorded in Matthew 25:31-45:

31"When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit on his throne in heavenly glory. 32All the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate the people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. 33He will put the sheep on his right and the goats on his left.

34"Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world. 35For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, 36 I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me.'

37"Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink? 38When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and clothe you? 39When did we see you sick or in prison and go to visit you?'

40"Then the King will reply, 'I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me.'

41"Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels. 42For I was hungry and you gave me nothing to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me nothing to drink, 43I was a stranger and you did not invite me in, I needed clothes and you did not clothe me, I was sick and in prison and you did not look after me.'

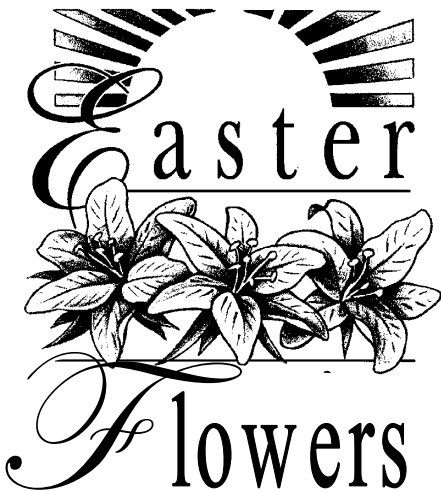
44"Then they also will answer, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or needing clothes or sick or in prison, and did not help you?'

45"Then he will reply, 'I tell you the truth, whatever you did not do for one of the least of these, you did not do for me.'

These are not just words, they are instructions. So call the florist today and order flowers for Someone Else's funeral service and be the instrument God meant for you to be in this world.

May God Bless all of you and your families. Remember God loves you and so do we.

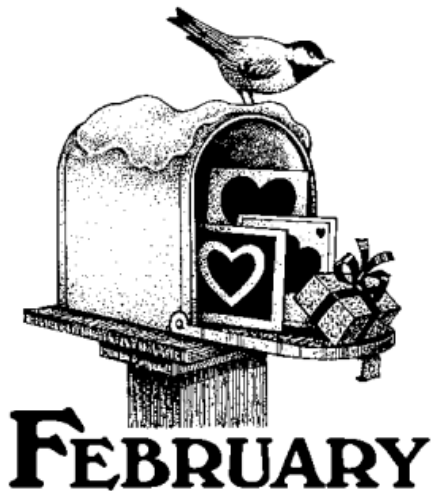
